Arts Council has coordinated music in the venues for Opening Night and organized payment for the musicians who have generously played for less than they would usually ask.

This year

Arts Council will provide the venues with a list of available musicians so they make arrangements directly with the musicians.

6.30 - 8.00pm

As in past years we plan to start the Walk at the Hotel Delatite. From there tour guides will take 'walkers' around the various art venues which will host solo, joint and group art exhibitions. It is expected that **musicians will play from 8.00 till 10.30** when the tours have finished and people are having dinner. But some venues may prefer musicians to play while the 'Walk' is happening between 6.30 - 8.00pm.

There may be opportunities to also play at other times during Spring Arts.
