CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 Entry form back by 10th October 2008. **No entries after this date will be accepted**
- 2 High Country Spring Arts 2008 officially opens on Friday 24th October and runs till Tuesday 4th November.
- 3 All artwork must be delivered, ready to hang or display, to the exhibiting venue on Wednesday 22nd October between 3.00 and 5.00pm strictly.
- 4 Works must be the original work of the artist, completed within the past year and not previously exhibited in the Mansfield district area.
- 5 Work must be signed and dated with title of work, medium and price.
- 6 All artists must have a connection with the Mansfield community or district.
- 7 Artworks that are part of a judging process must not be identifiable until after judging.
- 8 Entry Fee: **Each piece in all categories** - \$15 non-ACM Members. \$10 ACM Members **and** Free to ACM Members exhibiting in the 'Open Section'.
- 9 All Artwork must be for sale with the exception of artwork in the Median to Rare category.
- 10 Commission will be charged on all works sold at the rate of 20% on the price indicated on the entry form.
- 11 Prize monies are inclusive of any GST and no commission is charged on prize winning art works.
- 12 ACM will organise all sales and will give sales cheques, less commission, to artists within 2 weeks from 4th November 2008.
- 13 All artworks are hung in café and business venues in the township of Mansfield. Due to space limitations the organisers will ensure as much work as possible will be exhibited, and all works entered in a 'judged' exhibition will be judged.
- 14 The organising committee is not bound to exhibit any artwork.
- 15 Works delivered must be the same size and medium as on the entry form or it will not be accepted for exhibition.
- 16 The committee reserves the right to withdraw or reclassify entries not complying with the category entered.
- 17 The ACM nor any VENUE or EXHIBITION SPACE will not be responsible for the loss of, damage or breakage, of any art work, nor the insurance of exhibits in transit or on exhibition.
- 18 All work shall be installed at a venue with the supervision of a Hanging Supervisor who is an official volunteer of the Arts Council of Mansfield for this purpose.
- 19 Artist Public Liability Insurance: It is recommended that artists have their own PLI because in the event of a claim against a fault caused by the artist ie bad framing, un-secure hanger in this situation the artist may be liable.
- 20 All entry forms to be addressed to ARTS COUNCIL OF MANSFIELD, PO BOX 34, MANSFIELD, 3724
- 21 Judging will be done by an independent group of 5 people whose names have been put forward by event partners. The identity of judges is not made public.
- 22 Public Choice judging is by free public ballot.
- 23 The decision of judged exhibition shall be final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding such decisions.
- 24 Reproduction and Artist Statement: By signing this agreement, an Artist shall allow their work to be photographed without fee for media/advertising purposes. The Artist Statement may be used for media/advertising purposes.
- 25 Application for ACM Membership. Download the form from the website at: www.artsmansfield.com.
- 26 **Size of artwork that is to be hung.** Each piece of artwork must not occupy a space larger than a spatial area 1 x 1 metre including frame, unless by prior arrangement with ACM.
- 27 No exhibit shall be removed, before the closure of the Exhibition unless by consultation with ACM.
- 28 All unsold artwork to be collected after 5th November 2008.

Tasty and Tantalising: Visual art acquisitive prize. Work must be able to be hung.

Keeping Abreast: Sculptural/3D exhibition/ acquisitive prize. Create a 3D human bust from any media ie. Ceramic, resin, plaster etc and develop your artwork style on the piece. Must be able to self supporting or able to be hung on a wall. This exhibition will be opened on Thursday 23rd October at 1 Chenery St, Mansfield.

Open Section: Theme is open, any medium. Must be able to be hung on wall.

Median to Rare: Sculpture Exhibition. Includes an acquisitive prize and 3 public choice awards.

- Artwork set up by 8.30am. Removal between 4pm - 5pm on Saturday 1st November, 2008.
- Exhibition is for Saturday 1st November only **And/Or** artwork can be relocated by the Artist to the High Country Maze, 678 Goughs Bay Rd Goughs Bay on Sunday 2nd November by 8.30 am and removed by 6.00pm, and be part of the Mansfield Garden Club's open garden scheme.
- **NEW!** It is optional to put art work at the High Country Maze on Sunday. This is a new feature to give artists a longer selling time during the Festival.
- All artworks must be installed and removed by the artist on both days.
- Judging for Second Nature Eco-Village Acquisitive Prize will be completed by 9am on Saturday 1st November.
- All award winners announced at the exhibition between 3:30 and 4pm on Saturday 1st November.
- Judging for Public Choice Awards will be held by Public Ballot over the day of Saturday 1st November
- Exhibits must be suitable for outdoors.
- Exhibition site is the Median Strip between the Post Office and Mingo's, first in, best spot!

High Country Huts: Visual art acquisitive prize. Images of High Country Huts and medium any style.

artVision: 'artvision Mansfield' Award is \$1000 is a non-acquisitive prize. Broad spiritual traditions welcomed - including indigenous/Koorie art forms. Any medium in 2D. Must be able to be hung on wall.
