CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 Entry form back by 10th October 2009. **No entries after this date will be accepted**
- 2 Spring Arts Walk 2009 officially opens on Friday 23rd October and runs till Monday 2nd November.
- 3 All artwork must be delivered, ready to hang or display, to the exhibiting venue on Thursday 22nd October between 3.00 and 5.00pm strictly.
- 4 Works must be the original work of the artist, completed within the past year and not previously exhibited in the Mansfield district area.
- 5 Work must be signed and dated with title of work, medium and price.
- 6 All artists must have a connection with the Mansfield community or district. This can be any type of connection ie a friend or relative lived here, saw a show on television, always wanted to live here etc.
- 7 Entry Fee: **Each piece in all the above categories** - \$15 non-ACM Members. \$10 ACM Members.
- 8 All Artwork must be for sale with the exception of artwork in the Median to Rare category.
- 9 Commission will be charged on all works sold at the rate of 20% on the price indicated on the entry form.
- 10 Prize monies are inclusive of any GST and no commission is charged on prize winning art works.
- 11 ACM will organise all sales and will give sales cheques, less commission, to artists within 2 weeks of exhibition close.
- 12 All artworks are hung in café and business venues in the township of Mansfield. Due to space limitations the organisers will ensure as much work as possible will be exhibited, and all works entered in a 'judged' exhibition will be judged.
- 13 The organising committee is not bound to exhibit any artwork.
- 14 Works delivered must be the same size and medium as on the entry form or it will not be accepted for exhibition.
- 15 The committee reserves the right to withdraw or reclassify entries not complying with the category entered.
- 16 The ACM nor any VENUE or EXHIBITION SPACE will not be responsible for the loss of, damage or breakage, of any art work, nor the insurance of exhibits in transit or on exhibition.
- 17 Artist Public Liability Insurance: It is recommended that artists have their own PLI because in the event of a claim against a fault caused by the artist ie bad framing, un-secure hanger in this situation the artist may be liable.
- 18 Public Choice judging is by free public ballot.
- 19 The decision of judged exhibition shall be final, and no correspondence will be entered into regarding such decisions.
- 20 Reproduction of Artwork and Artist Statement: By signing this agreement, an Artist shall allow their work to be photographed without fee for media/advertising purposes. The Artist Statement may be used for media/advertising purposes.
- 21 **Size of artwork that is to be hung.** Each piece of artwork must not occupy a space larger than a spatial area 1 x 1 metre including frame, unless by prior arrangement with ACM.
- 22 No exhibit shall be removed, before the closure of the Exhibition unless by consultation with ACM.
- 23 All artwork to be collected by 5.00pm Sunday 1st November 2009.
- 24 **Spring Arts Auction:** Artists are invited to submit one art that has been part of the Spring Arts Walk to be included in the Spring Arts Auction at the Masonic Hall. Deliver one piece to the Masonic Hall between 3.00 – 5.00pm on Monday 2 November. ACM will make every effort to include all artwork in the Auction as time permits. Artists will set the reserve for their artworks and there will be a 10% commission charged for artwork sold at Auction.

- 26 In the event that these Conditions are changed, every effort will be made to advise artists of changes.

More information about the categories:

Head Above Water: Sculptural/3D exhibition/ acquisitive prize. Create a 3D sculpture in any media inspired by the theme. Must be able to self supporting or able to be hung on a wall.

Mansfield Visual Art Open section: Theme is open, any medium. Must be able to be hung on wall.

Median to Rare: Sculpture Exhibition. Includes an acquisitive prize and 3 public choice awards.

- Artwork set up by 8.30am. Removal between 4pm - 5pm on, Saturday 31st October 2009. Exhibition site is the Median Strip between the Post Office and Mingo's, first in, best spot!
- Judging for Second Nature Eco-Village Acquisitive Prize will be completed by 9am on Saturday 31st October.
- All award winners announced at the exhibition between 3:30 and 4pm.
- Judging for Public Choice Awards will be held by Public Ballot over the day.
- Exhibits must be suitable for outdoors.

artVision: 'artvision Mansfield' Award is \$1000 is a non-acquisitive prize. Broad spiritual traditions welcomed - including indigenous/Koorie art forms. Any medium in 2D. Must be able to be hung on wall.
